GENERAL GUIDELINES

- 1 The JUDGING PANEL shall comprise three persons, selected by the organisers, of whom one shall be designated as "Chairman"
- 2 There shall be EITHER ONE PANEL to cover BOTH Civic and Sporting Awards

OR

A SEPARATE JUDGING PANEL for each of the two classes of Awards.

- 3 The decisions of the Selection Panel(s) shall be FINAL AND BINDING.
- 4 To ensure that there shall be MAXIMUM coverage of the acknowledgement of service and achievement, whilst still limiting the Awards to the numbers stipulated, NO SINGLE PERSON shall receive MORE THAN ONE AWARD in any one year.
- 5 A person receiving an Award in any one section may be nominated for an Award and considered for selection in the following or any subsequent year.
- 6 UNSUCCESSFUL NOMINEES may be re-nominated in the year following or any subsequent years.

PREMIER SPORTS AWARD

- 1 This Award shall be made to the SPORTSMAN or SPORTSWOMAN judged to have given OUTSTANDING SERVICE to sport and recreational pursuits over a period of time either as a participator, coach or administrator.
- 2 Persons nominated must have had permanent residence within the Buller region during the twelve months prior to nomination.
- 3 While the main judging criteria will embrace activities within and beneficial to the Buller region consideration may also be given to long term or outstanding achievement beyond the district level where this has covered a reasonable span of years.
- 4 Dedication, ability and achievement to the benefit of the organisation(s) being served and to the advancement of sporting and recreational pursuits in the district as a whole will be the major factors in the assessment of the merit of the individual nominees.
